- <u>SFY 2019 STATE FUNDING APPLICATION</u>-Skip presented the proposed budget to members. Our grant is \$17,154 less than last year due to the start of a new tribal Early Head Start Program. Tribal and Migrant programs are funded first, then the remaining Head Start Programs are funded. This will result in serving 3 less Head Start children with State funds. Skip went through all the budget line items. Mountain Iron Buhl will be going to full day duration. Chisholm will be downsizing to one classroom. Skip is meeting with Mesabi East on Friday to discuss the future arrangements for the classroom. <u>Cherie Averill Manner moved to accept the SFY 2019 Funding</u> <u>Application supported by Diane Taylor. Motion carried unanimously.</u>
- <u>POLICIES AND PROCEDURES</u>- The Program Standards of Conduct Policy was updated to include the word "Abuse" as recommended by DHS licensing after the Hermantown review. <u>Kristy</u> <u>Johnson moved to accept the updated Program Standards of Conduct Policy supported by</u> <u>Diane Taylor. Motion carried unanimously.</u>

3. <u>OTHER</u>-Skip recommended Kelly Dey for the new Health Manager position. He reviewed her qualifications. <u>Diane Taylor moved to accept Kelly Dey as the new Health Manger supported</u> <u>by Angela Walker. Motion carried unanimously.</u>

The COLA application will need to be submitted once we receive our notice of funding and guidance from Region V. The application should be out soon. Next Policy Council meeting is June 13, 2018 at AEOA in Conference rooms 2 and 3.
