- 5 Documented disability of child
- 3 Suspected disability of child
- Not receiving prenatal care after 2+ months pregnant
- 3 Child/Family Safety Concerns
- 3 Lack of support for parent (from either family or community resources)
- 3 Family has written referral from another agency
- 5 Homeless Family (according to McKinney-Vento definition)
- 5 Foster Care placement
- 5 Verified Need for Respite Care
- 3 Repeater
- 1 Repeater (non-consecutive years)
