Maltreatment of Minors Mandated Reporting

Policy

Arrowhead Head Start staff, contractors, and volunteers are committed to the health and safety of all children. All staff, contractors, and volunteers will follow state and federal regulations for reporting any instances of or knowledge of child maltreatment including egregious harm, neglect, physical abuse, sexual abuse, substantial child endangerment, threatened injury, and mental injury. Maltreatment must be reported if witnessed, or if the individual has reason to believe that a child is being or has been maltreated within the last three years.

A mandated reporter who knows or has reason to believe a child is or has been maltreated and fails to report is guilty of a misdemeanor may be disqualified from a position allowing direct contact with, or access to, persons receiving services from programs, organizations.
