

Suspension and Expulsion

Policy:

Arrowhead Head Start will only use program suspension as a last resort in extraordinary circumstances where there is a serious safety threat that cannot be reduced through reasonable interventions and modifications. The program will work in coordination with the family to secure alternative services to support the child to ensure that the child's needs are being appropriately addressed, with the goal of allowing a safe and successful return to Head Start programming.

This policy complies with Head Start Performance Standard 45 CFR Section 1302.17
