Dear Parent/Guardian:

Someone in your child's classroom has the health issue below. This note is to tell you signs to watch for in your child. Call your doctor if your child has any of these signs.

If you have questions call the Head Start Health Manager, at 748-7336.

* **Lice:** An itchy head is the first sign. Look on the back of the neck and behind the ears first. Lice are tiny bugs about the size of a sesame seed. Their eggs (nits) are small white specks that are stuck like glue on the hair close to the scalp.

If your child has lice, he/she cannot come back to school until a treatment recommended by your child's health provider has been completed.

Call your Head Start teacher or the Health Manager right away if a doctor says your child has lice.
